We serve Christ in Crisis through our Five Ministry Teams:

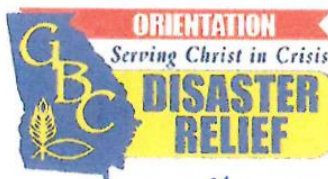
#### **Feeding, Clean-Up and Recovery, Child Care, Chaplaincy & Assessment**
